

StudentsStudent Organizations

The Superintendent shall approve formal student organizations, provide adequate supervision, and administer student finances for student organizations and activities. Student organizations, as a vital part of the total education program, should accomplish the following criteria:

- 1) Extend and reinforce the instructional program.
- 2) Give students practice in democratic self-government.
- 3) Develop student morale and support for the school.
- 4) Honor outstanding student achievement.
- 5) Provide wholesome social and recreational activities.

Student Trips to State and National Level Activities

Student groups and staff sponsors who desire to participate in state and national level activities under sponsorship of the school (in addition to those sponsored under the Nebraska School Activities Association) shall:

1. Obtain advanced approval from the principal before making arrangements to participate.
2. Obtain advanced approval from the Board of Education before making arrangements to participate.
3. Demonstrate that financing can be raised by students through Board approved fundraising activities or budgeted funds.
4. Assure the Board that adequate supervision and sponsors are provided and their expenses are included.

Students will be allowed to perform in these events only with proper permission and supervision and when the events do not disrupt the education program or other School District operations. The events must be approved by the Superintendent, unless it involves unusual travel and expense, in which case the Board must approve the performance. Board permission is required for any new activities which require overnight stay. After which, Superintendent approval is required to continue the activity on a year to year basis.

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
